



CONDITIONS OF APPLICATION FOR AGE QUALIFYING

1. A one off fee will register you to participate in as many qualifying rounds as you wish. This fee is non refundable.
2. Please note that you are still required to enter all junior tournaments separately. This application form is for State Age Championship Qualifying Only.
3. Scores will be recorded as they are received from the various golf clubs conducting the events.
4. Invitations will be issued directly from the JNJGF and no one other than the JNJGF has the authority to advise otherwise.
5. If you fax your registration form without credit card details, your application will not be processed until payment is received and you will not be eligible to qualify until this has occurred.
6. Qualifying for the 2010 Subaru State Age Championships will commence on the 1st of July 2009 and conclude on the 30th of June 2010.

ELIGIBILITY

- Open to all juniors (boys only) in the following age categories – 12 years & under, 13 years, 14 years, 15 years, 16 years, 17 years & 18 years.
- Age to apply as at Tuesday 13th July 2010
- All players who attempt to qualify must be members of the JNJGF.

ENTRY

- Qualifying is for boys only. Girls enter directly via the JNJGF but may be subject to a ballot.
- A competitor may still play in the qualifying tournaments even if he has already qualified.
- Exemptions apply for previous year's Age Champions, Current NSWGA State Junior Team Members, Members of the A.C.T Interstate Team and leading 10 eligible players on 2009 Junior Vardon. All these players will be informed by mail.
- Additional invitations will be issued from a pool of players according to their score against the CCR in age groups at the discretion of the JNJGF.

QUALIFIERS

The scratch winner in each age group at each qualifying event will qualify provided that there are at least six nominees in the Sydney Metropolitan Events, and three nominees in the Country Events and they have completed an age registration form. If there are not six and / or three nominees in any age group then those competitors who have registered to qualify will have their scores go into the pool from which additional invitations are issued. Once results from qualifying venues are received by the JNJGF an invitation and entry form will be sent to those who have qualified. Should any player be unable to contest the State Final his place will be declared vacant and filled by the next player in that age group pool on merit across the State. For any multi day events the daily and overall scratch winner in each age group will qualify providing all other conditions of the event are met.

JNJGF EVENTS

The daily and overall scratch winner and runner up of each age group will qualify providing they have completed the age registration form before the start of the event.
