

Dear Members,

A quick update prior to Christmas and the AGM next week, regarding the \$5.00 per player **Course Utilisation Fee (CUF)**

As previously mentioned last month the Board has considered reducing the competition fee to \$15.00, of which an additional \$2.00 will be quarantined inside the **existing course improvements fund** (This additional \$2.00 will be focussed on the irrigation replacement project), and I am pleased to say that this was endorsed unanimously by the Board.

Effective from Saturday 12/12/2020, competition fees will be reduced from \$18.00 to \$15.00 per player. Members are also advised that the CUF will also be removed from member social play.

The CUF collected so far, has been recorded in our P & L, and the balance will remain there should any further restrictions eventuate because of the COVID-19 pandemic.

As of Monday 7 December, the NSW Government imposed COVID-19 restrictions were relaxed, permitting patron levels to be one person per two (2) square metres. This combined with the operating results of October and November, provided the Board with the confidence to remove the \$5.00 Course Utilisation Fee.
