

NOTICE TO MEMBERS

CLUBHOUSE RE-OPENING – MONDAY 1ST JUNE 2020

- - - - UPDATED COVID-19 RESTRICTIONS - - - -

In accordance with the easing of restrictions on Clubs due to the COVID-19 pandemic, Queanbeyan Golf Club will be reopening the licensed premises from Monday 1st June 2020, and operating under the following guidelines issued by the NSW Department of Health;

1. Patrons **MUST NOT** enter the premises if they are displaying symptoms of respiratory illness (i.e. shortness of breath, dry or sore throat, coughing, sneezing)
2. Patrons **MUST NOT** enter the premises if they are displaying symptoms of fever (i.e. temperature above 38 degrees Celsius)
3. Patrons are requested to thoroughly wash their hands prior to attending the premises, and make use of the several hand sanitisation stations available throughout the club during their stay
4. Patrons **MUST** be prepared to follow the physical distancing guidelines and remain 1.5m away from other patrons when queuing. (Please follow floor markings in queuing areas)
5. It is a condition of entry that ALL patrons, staff and contractors **MUST** complete the daily attendance register as they enter the venue. Patrons are required to write their name, contact phone number or email address, as well as time of entry and time of exit.
6. Furniture within the venue has been placed in accordance with **STRICT** distancing provisions. Patrons **MUST NOT** rearrange tables or chairs within the venue at any time.
7. After being served, patrons **MUST** remain seated at all times. Once all seats are taken, the venue shall be determined as being fully occupied. Once fully occupied, no patrons may be admitted to the premises until vacancies exist by other patrons leaving.
8. Patrons **MAY NOT** form groups of ten (10) people or more, unless every member of the group reside in the same household.
9. Patrons **MUST** follow the directions of club employees and officials at all times. Failure to adhere to reasonable requests may result in you being asked to vacate the premises. Failure to leave the premises will result in Police being called to intervene.
10. Last but not least, please relax and enjoy yourselves! We are here to look after you, both in terms of our famous hospitality, but also to protect your health and safety.
